



Carvolth Integrated Open Space / Goldenview Park

Carvolth Integrated Open Space is a 16,200-square-meter linear green space located in Langley's Carvolth neighbourhood at the headwaters of the Serpentine River watershed. The Space was designed to receive stormwater from the surrounding 63,000-square-meter mixed-use site through a series of visible features that slow, clean and celebrate the water before it enters Latimer Creek. With water as the central thread, the concept thoughtfully combines form and function, weaving a curated collection of functions, programs, and communities into one public space. Water droplets delineate spaces and programs while also indicating the direction of water flow through the site, while visible stormwater features reinforce our understanding of and connection to the systems active on the site and to the larger ecosystem.
